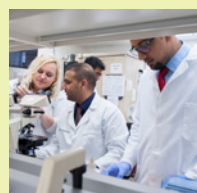

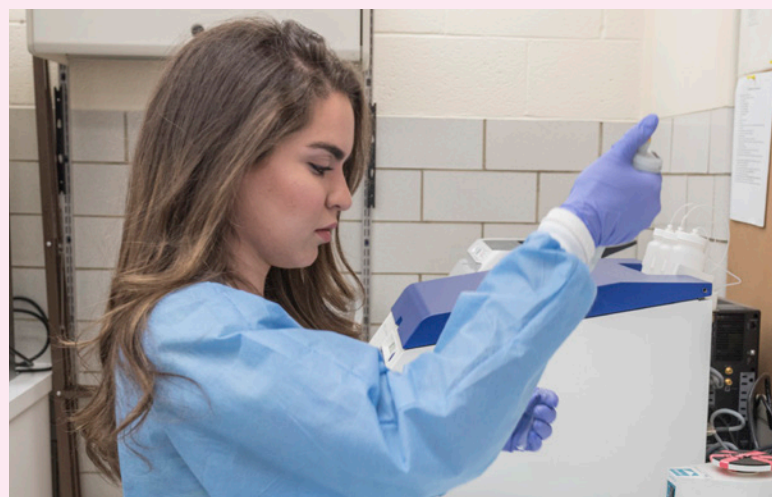

The Cleveland Clinic's American Center for Reproductive Medicine (ACRM) established in 1993 is dedicated to its mission of cutting-edge, disease-oriented research, teaching, training and patient care.

ACRM has an international reputation for excellence in innovative research in human fertility. Research papers from ACRM's faculty are selected regularly for publication in distinguished specialty medical journals. Researchers working within the Center lead the reproductive field with more than 670 scientific research articles and reviews in top peer reviewed scientific journals, >225 book chapters, and >800 papers at national and international scientific meetings. Its faculty has published over 26 medical text books/manuals related to Male Infertility, ART, Fertility Preservation, DNA Damage and Antioxidants that are highly sought after by researchers, physicians and ART practitioners.

More than 500 scientists and physicians from over 50 countries have received valuable training at ACRM during the past 25 years. Over 225 pre-med and medical students have participated in annual research internships with ACRM. In addition, over 180 clinicians, scientists and biologists have received hands-on training in various assisted reproductive techniques since 2003.

ACRM was recognized in 2011, 2013, and 2014 by the Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine for the innovative teaching curriculum used in its Annual Summer Internship Course. Case Western also presented the Center in 2013 with a Teaching Award for its Training Program in Advanced Reproductive (ART) Techniques. The Center's website has been ranked #1 for research in reproductive medicine and andrology since 2001, attracting over 1 million visitors.
