
Dear Dr. Agarwal,

I joined the program of research and training of the Glickman Urological Institute and Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology in January 2006. I submitted IRB for my study "Reproductive Outcome After Hysteroscopic Metroplasty" after obtaining the necessary certification for conducting research on human subjects (IRB/HIPPA).

I received hands-on training opportunities on routine semen analysis, Computer Assisted Semen Analysis (CASA), and sperm morphology assessment (WHO and Tygerberg strict criteria). During the training I also received excellent one-on-one training in preparation of ejaculated sperm for ART, sperm washing, double density gradient technique, and swim-up protocol.
