


History

- 34-year old woman with a known aortic coarctation (diagnosed at 16)
- Hypertension (2 meds) and mild renal insufficiency
- "My only option is open surgery"
- Decreased femoral pulses









Hybrid OR



Device and Treatment

- Pre-dilate with 8 mm PTA balloon (8 Atm)
- 24 mm x 105 mm Zenith Alpha (16 Fr)
- Serial Dilation to maximum of 14 mm (Conquest balloon)
- Elimination of pressure gradient/exclusion of pseudoaneurysm
