

## **Radiologic Technology and Other Medical Imaging Specialties**

---

Beginning a career in medical imaging technology requires attending an accredited program for one to four years depending on the degree or certificate obtained, the program's curriculum, and imaging modality selected. In general, most programs are two-year, full-time courses of study that are rigidly structured and include academic coursework and a significant number of clinical experience hours at a medical facility. Following successful completion of an educational program, individuals must take a national registration exam in order to practice in most states.
